What we do need to know is that ladies inside need the love and compassion of Jesus. Most come in and always want to leave right away, but after a couple weeks pass the affect of the drugs wears off, and they are away from the streets. Then many of them say to me, “I'm so glad we're in here, I could have died out there.” They know their lives need change, and we know change is possible through accepting Jesus into their lives and following Him. So we share the love and compassion of Christ with them and pray they accept Him and grow to love Him. Inside jail and out, people are in need of someone who loves them unconditionally, and His name is Jesus. Please pray for incarcerated women.
